Credit Score 101

Credit score. If you are someone who can read that word and not cringe, congratulations! For all others, this word has about as much power as the green money that brought it about. Your credit score number affects everything in your financial world. A higher number means more money in your pocket, where it belongs. So how do you improve that pesky digit? Look below for some of our suggestions!

First, check your credit report (click here for a link). Keeping track of your report is crucial because errors can appear. Catching these errors early will save you time and money. You should also ensure the amounts owed for each of your open accounts is correct. A late payment listed incorrectly is another error that frequently pops up. Conducting annual credit report checks is the first step in improving your score.

The next step is to set payment reminders. Paying on time

is one of the biggest contributing factors to a credit score. On Energy One's Online Bank site, there is an option to set a text message reminder or an alert sent to your e-mail.

> Finally, reducing the amount of debt you owe is the most important part. It is difficult but once you are no longer tethered to debt, the feeling will be far more satisfying than an improved credit score. Come up with a payment plan that funnels most of the available funds to debt payments with the highest interest rate. Once you have paid

those down, you can funnel those funds to the next loan. Continue with the process until you are debt free. Then, proceed to sing from the rooftops! JHill019
